COURSE OF STUDY

Classes are held each night, Monday--Thursday from 6:30 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. A student must attend at least two nights each week in order to complete the course of study in four years. All students must maintain a minimum GPA of at least 2.25. Students registering for the 2009-2010 Cooper Term (Fall) will have classes on Monday and Thursday nights. The application deadline for Cooper Term classes is June 15. 2009-2010 Cooper Term classes begin August 10, 2009. Students registering for the 2010 Henry Term (Spring) will have classes on Tuesday and Wednesday nights. The application deadline for Henry Term classes is December 15. 2010 Henry Term classes begin February 9, 2010.

TUITION

For Cooper Term 2009-2010 the tuition is \$424.00 per credit hour and for Henry Term 2010 the tuition has not been set. For Cooper Term 2009-2010 first year student taking the required 12 credit hours, this amounts to \$5088.00. Fees that must be paid at registration are \$200.00.
