

Graduates of law school in a foreign country are required by Tennessee Supreme Court Rule 7, section 7.01, if they choose to attend Nashville School of Law, to complete one-third of the credits necessary for graduation. That is sixteen credits. Nashville School of Law will certify those who successfully complete the following courses:
